



KANSAS STATE BOARD OF TECHNICAL PROFESSIONS DISCIPLINARY REPORT JUNE 2022

IN THE MATTER OF SAMUEL PAULL, PS115 CASE NO. 22-04

Summary: In July of 2021 the Board office received an alleged violation form on Mr. Paull. In the complaint it is alleged that Mr. Paul failed to make a reasonable search on controlling monuments.

Board Action: The board found Mr. Paull in violation of K.S.A 7026(a)(4).

Specifically, Mr. Paull failed to meet the minimum standards for the practice of surveying when he failed to file the required reference reports with the Kansas Historical Society.

The conduct of Mr. Paull, as outlined above, constitutes violation of the laws of the State of Kansas.

Board Action: The Board fined Mr. Paull \$500.00 plus costs.

Status: The case was closed December 2021.

IN THE MATTER OF ATLAS SURVEYORS, LLC, LS-324 CASE NO. 21-23

Summary: In February of 2021 the Board office received an alleged violation form on Atlas Surveyors, LLC. In the complaint it is alleged that Atlas Surveyors, LLC failed to set monuments, labeled “found monuments” on plats that weren’t there and claims to have searched for monuments and reset their own.

Board Action: The board found Atlas Surveyors, LLC in violation of K.S.A 74-7026(a)(4).

Specifically, Atlas Surveyors failed to meet the minimum standards for the practice of surveying when they failed to show in the survey that all of the corners shown on the Final Plat were set.

The conduct of Atlas Surveyors, as outlined above, constitutes violation of the laws of the State of Kansas.

Board Action: The Board fined Atlas Surveyors, LLC \$500.00 plus costs.

Status: The case was closed February 2022.
