F. Discussion of Licensure Requirements for Surveying Applicants

By motion of Mr. Lilak, seconded by Mr. Graham, the Committee voted to add an alternative path to licensure for Surveying applicants to include a minimum of 12 credit hours and 8 years of experience. Global Positioning Systems, Property Law, Boundary Control and Surveying Analysis will be required within the 12 credit hour minimum. Six of the minimum eight years of experience must be progressive surveying. Mr. Haverkamp will formally present the new option to the Board at the December 13, 2019 meeting.

G. NCEES Resolution of Cooperation Review

The Committee directed Mr. Karns to send the resolution to the Board in December for adoption.

A. KSS Exam Consultant Discussion

Mr. Karns updated the Committee regarding the KSS Exam Consultant search / bid process. He will hold a meeting Monday, September 23, 2019 with the Procurement office to begin the process.
