

IN THE MATTER OF CHRISTOPHER FEIN AND FEIN + WINEINGER ARCHITECTURE

Summary: The Kansas State Board of Technical Professions received an inquiry concerning Christopher Fein who is a founding principal of Fein + Wineinger Architecture. The inquiry concerned whether or not Mr. Fein held a license to practice architecture in the State of Kansas and whether the firm of Fein + Wineinger Architecture held a certificate of authorization to practice the technical profession of architecture in the state of Kansas. Following receipt of the letter of inquiry, the Board directed that an investigation be conducted by one of its investigators for the purpose of determining whether or not Mr. Fein and Fein + Wineinger Architects were practicing, offering to practice or holding themselves out as authorized to practice architecture without benefit of a license or certificate of authorization.

Board Action: Following the completion of the requested investigation, Christopher Fein + Wineinger Architecture and the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions entered into a Settlement Agreement and Consent Order which included the following provisions:

- The respondents Christopher Fein and Fein + Wineinger Architecture admitted that they have offered to practice or held themselves out as authorized to practice the technical profession of architecture in the State of Kansas without being licensed to do so.
- 2. The respondents shall immediately cease and desist

- from practicing, offering to practice or holding themselves out as authorized to practice the technical profession of architecture in the State of Kansas until such time as they have been licensed to do so.
- 3. The respondents shall immediately cease and desist from referring to themselves as architects or from using the term architect, architectural services or architectural design or referring to themselves as providing such services in the State of Kansas until such time as they have been licensed to do so.
- 4. The respondents shall immediately cease and desist from using any letterheads, business cards, websites, or any advertisements, including telephone book listings in the State of Kansas which refer to them as providing architectural services or architectural design or drafting services.
- 5. Respondents shall pay a fine in the amount of \$500 and all expenses of the Board including attorney fees and investigative expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter in the amount of \$900 for a total fine and cost of \$1,400.

Status: Said fine and costs have been paid and the file has been closed.

IN THE MATTER OF RICHARD MATTSON

Summary: On or about June 14, 2010, the Complaint Committee of the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions received an inquiry regarding respondent's surveying practices and surveying work performed by respondent in Meade County and Gray County, Kansas. As a result of the inquiry, the Complaint Committee of the Board directed that the matter be investigated by one of the Board's licensed land surveyor investigators. Said investigation resulted in the determination that Mr. Mattson had deviated from generally accepted land surveying practices and/or from the minimum standard for boundary surveys when the surveys were performed.

Board Action: Following the completion of said investigation by the Board, Mr. Mattson and the Kansas State

Board of Technical Professions entered into a Settlement Agreement and Consent Order which included the following terms:

- 1. The respondent admitted that he had deviated from acceptable land surveying practices and/or the minimum standards for boundary surveys in performing the surveys in Meade County and Gray County, Kansas.
- 2. The respondent shall immediately conform his land surveying practices to generally accepted land surveying practices in the State of Kansas and to the minimum standards for boundary surveys as adopted by the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions in K.A.R. 66-12-1.
- 3. Respondent shall pay all expenses of the Board including attorney fees and investigation costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of this matter in the amount of \$2,012.50 and a civil fine in the amount of \$500 for a total of \$2,512.50.

Status: Mr. Mattson has paid the fine and costs imposed in this matter and has fulfilled all of the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, and the case file has been closed. Mr. Mattson's land surveying license in the State of Kansas is presently in good standing.

The Following Individuals No Longer Hold a Valid Kansas License:

<u>Dennis Stanley Nelson</u>–Reinstatement of Mr. Nelson's license to practice engineering in the State of Kansas was denied effective March 8, 2011.

<u>Kenneth Kirk Shoemaker</u>–Mr. Shoemaker's license to practice engineering in the State of Kansas was revoked effective December 30, 2010.

On the web page, click on the "LICENSURE CARD" link. You will be asked to log in with your license number and last four digits of your social security number. Verify your address information and click "continue" to be taken to your individual on-line CERTIFICATE OF RENEWAL (or licensure card) for printing. This "LICENSURE CARD" has the same information as the phased-out wallet card.



REMINDER **Surveyor Education Requirements for Licensure** Changing on June 30, 2012

All applicants for a Land Surveyor license by exam are reminded that applicants for the PS exam must apply no later than June 30, 2012 if applying with experience only. Any application received July 1, 2012 or after must be based on educational requirements as listed in K.A.R. 66-

Exceptions to this requirement are those individuals who have previously applied to take either the FS or PS exam and have been approved by the Kansas Board.

Comity applicants who are originally licensed after June 30, 2012 will also be required to meet the educational requirements of K.A.R. 66-9-5.



NCARB Annual Meeting Report

The 92nd annual meeting of the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards was held June 22 through June 25 in Washington D.C. There were 144 delegates and 52 of the Member Registration Boards represented at the meeting and conference. Representing the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions were architect members Dave Hoffman, FAIA and Vince Mancini, AIA; landscape architect member Phil Meyer, ASLA and Jean Boline, Executive Director.

During past NCARB regional and annual meetings, Kansas board members participated with other state board members in developing a strategic plan for NCARB. Following are the five (5) goals from the finalized 2011 strategic plan that were presented during the meeting:

- A. All Member Boards will accept the NCARB Certificate for reciprocal registration and all architects will actively seek certification.
- B. Member Boards, registered architects and emerging professionals will have appropriate access to an NCARB hosted central database of credentials.
- C. All architectural collateral organizations will contribute to and value an expanded practice analysis and will use common terms to define the expected outcomes for architectural education, internship, examination and continuing education.
- D. Internship will be viewed as a valued part of the development of future architects by interns, supervisors, educators and the profession; and, all architecture students will be enrolled in the Intern Development Program at the earliest point of eligibility.
- E. All Member Boards will adopt and implement NCARB standards for continuing education.

Along with the new strategic plan, the results of the candidate search for a new NCARB CEO was announced. Michael J. Armstrong will assume the role of NCARB Chief Executive Officer. Further information on Armstrong's remarks to the delegates, his background and qualifications can also be found at the NCARB web site.

Thirteen resolutions were discussed and approved by the member board delegates. The following resolutions were the major issues passed:

Resolution 01: Model Law and Model Regulation Amendments-Changes to Continuing Education Requirements:

This resolution aims to bring uniformity to continuing education requirements, terminology,

Certificate of Authorization Renewals Business Entities M-Z Due December 31, 2011

Due to changes in K.S.A. 74-7036 passed by the 2010 legislature, the renewal schedule for Certificates of Authorization was modified. Previously all business entities renewed their certificates in even numbered years.

When certificates were renewed in December 2010, those businesses whose names begin with A-L renewed for a two-year period. Those businesses whose names begin with M-Z renewed for only one year.

To be placed on the new two-year renewal schedule, business entities whose names begin with M-Z will need to renew by December 31, 2011 for a two year period for a fee of \$95.00. Renewal Notices for Certificates of Authorization will be sent to currently licensed business entities whose names begin with M-Z by November 1, 2011. This renewal will be good through December 31, 2013

Business entities whose names begin with A-L will receive a renewal notice in November 2012 with \$95.00 due for the biennial renewal through December 31, 2014.

Renewals will be on the following biennial schedule:

Certificate of Authorization for **Business Entities A-L** \$95.00 due in even years

Certificate of Authorization for **Business Entities M-Z** \$95.00 due in odd years

types of hours, number of hours and renewal dates that differ in each member board jurisdiction. This change to model law, when approved and implemented by a member board, will lead to greater standardization of continuing education requirements, improved course content and quality, and simplified record keeping processes for member boards. This will also ease the burden for practitioners licensed in multiple jurisdictions. The number of recommended continuing education (CE) hours is 12 per year, all Health, Safety and Welfare (HSW).

Resolution 03 and 04: Handbook for Interns and Architects Amendments – Modifications to Broadly Experienced Architect (BEA) requirements and Broadly Experienced Foreign Architect (BEFA) Requirements.

Resolution 03 permits a path for a registered applicant within a jurisdiction (without a NAAB accredited degree) to obtain NCARB certification by demonstrating that a combination of education and/or comprehensive practice satisfies their education deficiencies with respect to the NCARB education standard set forth in the education guidelines. Resolution 04 provides a path for a broadly experienced foreign architect (registered in their country of origin) to obtain NCARB certification.

FY 2012 President Scott C. Veazey shared his vision to focus on implementing the first stages of NCARB's Strategic Plan during his presidency with us. Also, in FY 2012 the Practice Analysis of Architecture will occur. This is a nation-wide survey to identify the knowledge and skills that are necessary to practice architecture. The results will be used to update the ARE examination, the Intern Development Program and the education requirements which are the basis for licensure by jurisdictions.

Landscape Architect Registration Exam (L.A.R.E.) Changes Coming September 2012

Candidates are encouraged to complete the current exam by June 2012

The Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards has announced changes to the exam that will take affect with the September 2012 administration of the Landscape Architect Registration Examination (L.A.R.E.).

Changes to the exam will include:

1. Five to four sections—This modest structural change will better align the content of the L.A.R.E. with current practice, as demonstrated in the 2010 Task Analysis study. For additional detail on equivalency between the current and new exam, view the transition chart.

Section 1–Project and Construction Management

Section 2–Inventory and Analysis

Section 3-Design

Section 4–Grading, Drainage and Construction Documentation

2. <u>Full computer based testing</u>—By December 2012 all four sections will be delivered by computer to improve relevance, reliability, and accessibility.

Meanwhile candidates are encouraged to continue taking the current exam, especially those that have already started the exam process. Because the content that is currently tested in Section D will be split between Sections 3 and 4 in the new exam, candidates already in the exam process should complete the current exam to avoid losing credit for Sections C, D or E.

New candidates are also encouraged to begin the exam process as soon as possible to obtain licensure. Obtaining licensure is an important career goal that makes you a more marketable professional—particularly in challenging economic times. There is ample time to complete the current exam and become licensed prior to the transition to the new exam in September 2012.

Additionally, completing the current exam has financial benefits for current and new candidates as well. The cost per section of the new exam will go up because the costs must be spread across four sections instead of five.
